CLUBS / ACTIVITIES SPRING 2024

We have expanded after-school offerings to include more vendor clubs as well as more low-cost activities in the hopes to make programming more accessible and inclusive to all students. There will be two separate sign-up processes again; one for unaffiliated vendor clubs hosted at Lee and one for clubs partially subsidized by the PTA and led by our awesome volunteers! After receiving feedback from the community, there will be a \$50 per semester suggested donation for non-vendor club enrollment, and the remaining cost for the program will be supplemented by the PTA. Everyone is welcome to join our enrichment clubs regardless of ability to pay. Caregivers will be given the opportunity to donate additional funds to cover the cost of programming for students who could use additional financial support.

After-school enrichment clubs do not take the place of aftercare, are typically only for one hour per week, space is not guaranteed, and most clubs are only for one semester.
